Certificate Cost

All courses are three graduate credit hours. Tuition is \$260 per credit hour, plus student fees.

Certificate Structure

In order to construct a more complete foundation in, and understanding of, the process of 'best practice' coaching, it is recommended that these courses be taken in sequence. All three courses meet in Denver three weekends including Friday evening and all day Saturday. Courses also require field work. Students can register for these courses as either undergraduate or graduatelevel credit.
