What is a Mobile Pantry?

Mobile pantries are free food distributions for people in need. Food Bank of the Rockies brings an assortment of food in a large refrigerated semi-truck. Food is distributed free to anyone needing a little extra help.

When:

Every third Thursday of the month starting March 21, 2019.

Distribution begins 1:00 pm and ends when all the food is distributed, usually in about an hour. Arriving no later than 1:30 is recommended.

Where:

9065 Grant ST - Parking lot on the northwest corner of Grant Street and Russell Boulevard

What to Expect and Bring:

Fresh produce, dairy, bread and other nutritious items distributed to anyone with a self-declared need for assistance.

Dress in appropriate clothing for outdoor distribution.

Bring reusable bags, boxes, carts, etc. to carry food to your vehicle.
