



TANF HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHO IS THIS FOR: Adams County residents who need short-term financial assistance to pay for rent or mortgage.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must have a dependent in the home who is 18 or under. If dependent is 18, they must be currently enrolled in school.
 - Must be legally-documented residents of the United States.
- Must have an annual household income of less than \$75,000 annually
 - Must be at risk of homelessness
- Must NOT be currently receiving TANF/Colorado Works

HOW TO APPLY:

Call the Family Tree Homelessness Program to schedule an assessment:

In order to provide timely assistance, we ask that all adult members of the household are present for the assessment and you are able to provide the following documentation:

- Photo identification and social security cards for all members of the household
 - Proof of income (child support, employment, unemployment)
 - Proof of homelessness risk (notices from landlord, past due bills)
 - Copy of your lease (if applicable)
