(the 3 most common)

An Early Childhood Teacher is assigned responsibility for a single group of children and working under the supervision of a Director and must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.

EARLY CHILDHOOD TEACHER QUALIFICATION PATHWAY VERIFICATION WORKSHEET 7.702.45.A.1

Completion of two (2) three (3) semester credit hour courses from an accredited college or university in Early Childhood Education;

- One (1) of the courses must be either Intro to ECE, Guidance Strategies OR the Department approved Pyramid Plus Training.
- The second course can be any other ECE course including Expanding Quality in Infant-Toddler Care course (EQIT)

Twenty-one (21) months (3,185 hours) of verified experience in the care and supervision of four (4) or more children less than eight (8) years of age who are not related to the individual. Satisfactory experience includes being a licensee of a Colorado Family Child Care Home, a Teacher's Aide or Teacher in a childcare center, preschool, or elementary school.
