
FAMILY LEADERS TOUR THE CAPITAL

Family Leaders were asked to undertake a community project to impact change in how Adams County supports healthy families. Family leaders selected a mental health project where they will work to see a change in awareness, prevent stigma and build partnerships. So far, families have completed a listening session and focus group around the Cover all Coloradans legislation, met with Adams County Health Department and created their own mental health messages. Next, leaders have been asked to provide feedback on all letstalkco.org messages and report back to the Health Department. In the coming months, leaders also hope to host a Panel of Officials that hopefully will include school districts, the health department, city officials from adams county and others.

Families were visited by two representatives from Adams County Health Department about the concerns they had with messages currently being circulated by letstalkco.org as well as materials from the postpartum depression awareness campaign.
