

SUPPORT AFFORDABLE CHILD CARE IN ADAMS COUNTY THROUGH TAX CREDITS!

Child care allows working parents to devote more attention to the workplace, ensuring higher productivity and business revenue. Access to available and affordable child care is a top need for working parents with children in Adams County. Your business can be a part of the solution!

Through the Colorado Child Care Contribution Tax Credit (CCCTC), people and businesses can contribute to support child care.

How does the tax credit work?

You can claim a Colorado tax credit for half (50%) of your donation, worth up to \$100,000 per tax year.

- You provide monetary donations directly to a child care program or an intermediary organization.
- After donating, you will receive the DR 1317 Child Care Contribution Tax Credit Certification form from the organization. You will need to submit this Certification to the state.
- If you itemize deductions, you can still claim your full contribution as a charitable deduction on your federal and state returns.

Tax Credit Guidelines:

- You can claim up to \$100,000 or your actual Colorado income tax liability, whichever is less (per tax year).
- You can carry over any unused credit for up to five additional tax years.
- · Only monetary donations are eligible.

Where can I donate?

You can donate directly to the Early Childhood Partnership of Adams County (ECPAC), which works to address the systemic barriers to affordable child care from both the family and program perspective.
