Program Requirements

To be eligible for the \$950 Materials Grant, providers must:

- ✓ Attend 3 ECPAC Trainings
 - 1 FFN-specific training
 - 2 trainings for all early childhood providers
- ✓ Attend 1 in-person Learn & Play or Lunch & Learn event
- ✓ Participate in 1 technical assistance meeting with an ECPAC navigator

Materials Grant

Upon completion of the eligibility requirements, participants will qualify for a \$950 Materials Grant. This grant can be used to purchase resources that support early childhood development and create a high-quality learning environment from Lakeshore Learning Materials.
